

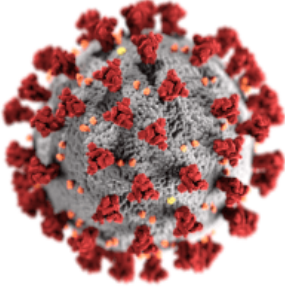

COVID-19 POLICIES



As you probably expect, in order to hold this event, we will be subject to the guidelines of the CDC, the State of Missouri, and Jackson County for occupancy limits and social distancing procedures.

1. Jackson County Health Department has a mask mandate in effect, and we expect that it will still be in effect during the MOUSBC Women's Championships. **MASKS ARE REQUIRED** unless you are **ACTIVELY** eating, drinking, or taking your turn on the lanes. It is suggested that you pull your mask down while involved in those activities, so that it is available when you might need it. You must have your mask on while on the concourse, using the restrooms, etc. There will be no leniency with this requirement by the bowling center. They have too much to lose.
2. Tournament staff will wear masks anytime there are face-to-face dealing with participants.
3. At this time, the capacity limits in Jackson County for bowling centers is 50%. **This is IMPORTANT.** A squad of 24 teams will put Lunar Bowl at its maximum capacity, which will not allow for spectators during your squad. If your squad is close to being full, and you want or need to bring someone with you while you bowl, **YOU** will need to make prior arrangements with the bowling center. It will be the bowling center, **NOT** MOUSBC, that enforces the capacity limit. If that changes again, we will publicize that.
4. We will **NOT** be allowing check-in for any squad earlier than one-hour prior to the squad starting time. Once your squad is completed, we ask that you pack up and exit the building.
5. Tournament recaps will be used. If scorekeepers are not present on your squad, we ask that one person from each team take charge of the scoresheet to limit the number of people interacting with the recap boards. They will be sanitized between squads before re-use.
6. We reiterate our change in tournament policies for this year. We will issue refunds prior to bowling **FOR ANY REASON** up until the end of the tournament. **PLEASE**, if you're feeling ill on the weekend you are scheduled to bowl, stay home. If you have issue with any of our policies, please understand that we are doing what we think is best for the event. If you disagree, just ask for a refund.
