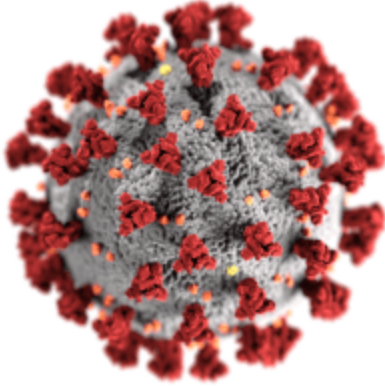




2020 MOUSBC SENIOR CHAMPIONSHIPS

COVID-19 POLICIES



As you probably expect, in order to hold this event, we will be subject to the guidelines of the CDC, the State of Missouri, and Laclede County for occupancy limits and social distancing procedures.

1. Starlite Lanes in Lebanon has 16 lanes, and we'll be using all of them on some squads. With three Doubles teams to a pair, that puts our maximum squad size at 48. Allowing for tournament staff and bowling center staff, we will be able to stay under the 50% occupancy number of 65.
2. We are asking that no spectators accompany you while you are bowling your squad. If there is a specific need for this to happen, please contact the bowling center to make arrangements ahead of time. It will ultimately be the bowling center's decision whether this can happen or not, based on squad sizes.
3. While we understand that this is both a bowling event and a social event, we ask that when you're finished bowling your squad, if there is a squad following yours, that you pack up and exit the building expeditiously. We have added one hour between the Saturday afternoon and evening squads to make that easier. Sunday morning will still be challenging. We need your cooperation.
4. We will NOT be allowing check-in for any squad earlier than one-hour prior to the squad starting time.
5. Masks are strongly recommended anytime you're on the concourse, making use of restrooms, ordering from snack bar or bar, or interacting with the front desk. Masks are not mandated in Laclede County. Tournament staff will be encouraged to wear masks when interacting with tournament bowlers.
6. Tournament recaps will not be used for reporting scores to the tournament office. We will get the scores from the scoring system, so it is important that you make sure the score in the computer system is correct. We will pass out recaps for your use at the lanes. If you'd like a record of your scores, we recommend that you take a picture of the recap with your phone.
7. We reiterate our change in tournament policies for this year. We are waiving all late fees, taking entries up until 30 minutes prior to a squad if lanes are available. We will issue refunds FOR ANY REASON up until the end of the tournament. PLEASE, if you're feeling ill on the weekend you are scheduled to bowl, stay home. If you have issue with any of our policies, please understand that we are doing what we think is best for the event, and we understand if you disagree. Just ask for a refund.
