2020 Tournament Rules

- This tournament will be open to all female members of any local USBC chartered association in the State of Missouri and will be conducted under the rules and regulations of the United States Bowling Congress. Non-members who reside in the jurisdiction of these associations who are not members of another state association can become eligible by the purchase of a USBC membership card. A USBC member who is a non-resident of Missouri may participate in the tournament by paying the local association dues in the association where the tournament is being hosted. Only one such member per doubles team.
- Entrants are eligible to bowl twice in each event in this tournament; however, you must change partners for doubles to cash again. If you enter doubles, you must enter singles and vice versa. Multiple entrants may only enter All-Events once, and the first time bowling will count as the All-Events score regardless of when entries are paid.
- You **MUST** have reached your 50th birthday by the first day of the tournament to be eligible to bowl in the tournament. **THERE IS NO REQUIREMENT TO BOWL IN A SENIOR LEAGUE TO COMPETE.**
- Handicap is 90% of the difference between the highest certified average and 210 for singles, and 420 for doubles.
 - Previous season's highest (standard or adjusted sport/challenge) for 21 games or more in any association area. If not a., then:
 - Previous season's highest (standard or adjusted sport/challenge) for 12 games or more in any association area. If not b., then:
 - If no average from previous season, use the highest current (standard or adjusted sport/challenge) season average at time of participation based on 12 games. (MUST BRING AN INDIVIDUAL BOWLER RECORD, CURRENT LEAGUE SHEET, OR PROVIDE THE ABILITY TO CHECK STANDINGS AND AVERAGES ON THE INTERNET AT THE TIME OF BOWLING). If not c., then:
 - If none of these applies, bowler will use 210 and bowl scratch.
- All bowlers should be familiar with USBC Rule 319. Sections a, b, and e apply, with the exception of 319a2 (no 10-pin rule for this tournament.) Rule 319c will be strictly enforced. Rule 319d will not apply.
- Entry Fee must accompany entry form. No refund made after September 10, 2020.
- There will be six (6) divisions: Division 1 (75 years and above), Division 2 (70 to 74), Division 3 (65 to 69), Division 4 (60 to 64), Division 5 (55 to 59), and Division 6 (50 to 54). These divisions will apply to Singles and All-Events Only. Doubles will have only one division and partners DO NOT have to be in the same age group. **Date of birth for each bowler must be shown on entry form.**
- Participants must be members in good standing of the USBC and agree to bowl on lanes assigned to them. Memberships will be verified. Violation of USBC or tournament rules could result in disqualification.
- The prize ratio is one for each eight entries, and prize fees are returned 100%.
- Late entries allowed subject to availability of lanes up to one hour before squad. Cash or credit card only. \$5 per person late fee will be assessed for entries submitted or postmarked after September 10, 2020. Entries close October, 25, 2020.**
- The entrants whose names appear hereon or their authorized replacement hereby agree that the Missouri State USBC shall be liable ONLY to the extent of returned entry fees if and when these entrants shall be prevented from bowling any event in the tournament through delay, unexpected yet necessary schedule change, or premature termination of the tournament which may be brought about by war, national emergency or emergencies or causes relating thereto or resulting therefrom, fires, strikes, lockouts, labor difficulties, pandemic, or causes beyond the control of the Missouri State USBC.
- The MOUSBC Tournament Committee shall decide any question not covered by these rules, and have power to hear and act on all protests. Tournament Committee decisions will be final unless appealed in accordance with USBC Rule 329.
- All Events Champions in six age divisions will have their entry fee paid by the Missouri State USBC to the National Senior Championships. National Age Divisions are: Super Senior—75 and up; A—70-74; B—65-69; C—60-64; D—55-59; and E—50-54 years.

Thanks for entering the 2020 Senior Women's Championships. We also urge you to bowl in the Missouri State USBC Women's Championships, to be held in Kansas City starting in March 2021. Entry forms will be available on our website: www.MOUSBC.org.
