2025 Tournament Rules

- 1. This tournament will be open to all members of any local USBC chartered association in the State of Missouri and will be conducted under the rules and regulations of the United States Bowling Congress. Non-members who reside in the jurisdiction of these associations can become eligible by the purchase of an appropriate USBC membership (full or local/state). A USBC member who is a non-resident of Missouri may participate in the tournament by paying the local/state dues in the association where the tournament is being hosted.
- 2. Entrants are eligible to bowl twice in each event in this tournament; however, you must change partners for doubles to cash again. If you enter doubles, you must enter singles and vice versa. Entrants may cash in singles twice. Multiple entrants may only enter All-Events once, and the first time bowling will count as the All-Events score regardless of when entries are paid.
- You MUST have reached your 50th birthday by the first day of the tournament to be eligible to bowl in the tournament. THERE IS NO REQUIREMENT TO BOWL IN A SENIOR LEAGUE TO COMPETE.
- Handicap is 90% of the difference between the highest certified average and 220 for singles, and 440 for doubles.
 - a. Previous season's highest (standard or adjusted sport/challenge) for 21 games or more in any association area. If not a., then:
 - b. If no average from previous season, use the highest current season average (standard or adjusted sport/challenge) at time of participation based on 12 games. (MUST BRING AN INDIVIDUAL BOWLER RECORD, CURRENT LEAGUE SHEET, OR PROVIDE THE ABILITY TO CHECK STANDINGS AND AVERAGES ON THE INTERNET AT THE TIME OF BOWLING). If not b., then:
 - c. If none of these applies, bowler will use 220 and bowl scratch.
- All bowlers should be familiar with USBC Rule 319. Sections a, b, and e apply, with the exception of 319a2 (no 10-pin rule for this tournament.) Rule 319c & 319d will be strictly enforced.
- 6. Entry Fee must accompany entry form. No refund made after August 31, 2023.
- 7. There will be three (3) divisions: Division 3 (50 to 59), Division 2 (60 to 69), and Division 1 (70 and over). These divisions will apply to Singles and All-Events Only. Doubles will have only one division and partners DO NOT have to be in the same age group. Date of birth for each bowler must be shown on entry form.
- 8. Participants must be members in good standing of the USBC and agree to bowl on lanes assigned to them. Memberships will be verified. Violation of USBC or tournament rules could result in disqualification.
- 9. The prize ratio is one for each eight entries, and prize fees are returned 100%.
- Late entries allowed subject to availability of lanes up to one hour before squad. Cash or credit card only. \$5 per person late fee will be assessed for entries submitted or postmarked after August 27, 2025. Entries close October 19, 2025.
- 11. An optional scratch division for each event (including All-Events) is available at a cost of \$5 per event. A bowler may enter any or all of these optional divisions at the time of bowling with no penalty. If entering Scratch Doubles, both doubles partners must enter.

- 12. The entrants whose names appear hereon or their authorized replacement hereby agree that the Missouri State USBC shall be liable ONLY to the extent of returned entry fees if and when these entrants shall be prevented from bowling any event in the tournament through delay, unexpected yet necessary schedule change, or premature termination of the tournament which may be brought about by war, national emergency or emergencies or causes relating thereto or resulting therefrom, fires, strikes, lockouts, labor difficulties, pandemic, or causes beyond the control of the Missouri State USBC.
- 13. The MOUSBC Tournament Committee shall decide any question not covered by these rules, and have power to hear and act on all protests. Tournament Committee decisions will be final unless appealed in accordance with USBC Rule 329.
- 14. **The High All-Events Score** in six age divisions (based on your age on July 1, 2026) will have their entry fee paid by the Missouri State USBC to the National Senior Championships. National Age Divisions are: Super Senior—75 and up; A—70-74; B—65-69; C—60-64; D—55-59; and E—50-54 years. For tournament divisions spanning ten years, the highest score for each of the five year ranges above will be determined and those entrants will qualify for the National Senior Championships.
- 15. Overpayments of \$10 or less will be donated to BVL. Calculate your payments carefully.
